AN UPDATE ON LENTEN WORSHIP SERVICES -- Throughout Lent we will be using unleavened bread. The apostle Paul, in 1 Corinthians encouraged the gentile church to “keep the feast, not with old leaven but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.” Additionally, we will intinct (dip) the unleavened bread in the wine. Using unleavened bread and wine served from pottery chalices further reinforces the concepts of simplicity and fasting during the Lenten Season. On Easter Sunday we will return to using wafers at the 8AM service and regular leavened bread at the 10:30AM service. Wine will be served in communion cups at both services.

“CHRIST ON TRIAL” LENTEN SERVICES – We will continue on Wednesday, March 20 at 7:00 p.m. with the next segment of this intriguing Lenten series. Please join us as *the healed woman* is brought to the witness stand to tell her story in defense of the man Jesus Christ. Prior to the service at 6 PM, a simple soup and bread dinner will be served. Also, James Alfieri, our church’s Director will begin playing the organ in the sanctuary at 6:45 PM as a pre-service type of devotion. All are invited as we continue our Lenten journey.

The service time was originally set for 10AM, however, it has since been changed to **9:30AM** to be more of a compromise between the early and the late normal service times.
