CPR/AED TRAINING: APRIL 30 AFTER WORSHIP IN THE ZONE

Do you know how to perform "Hands Only CPR" to help someone who has collapsed? Are you aware that Zion has an Automated External Defibrillator (AED)? Do you know where it is stored and how to use it? If you are interested in learning about CPR and using



an AED in an emergency, come to the Zone after the church service. We will view two short (less than 5 minutes) videos from the American Heart Association which demonstrate "Hands Only CPR" and how to use an AED. We will also discuss some things to remember if and when an emergency occurs at Zion. We strongly encourage at least one member of each usher team to attend!

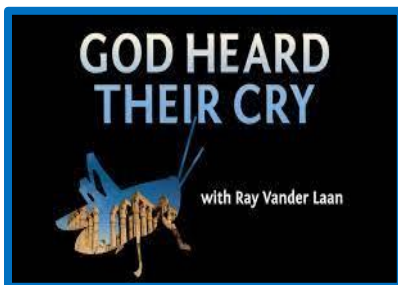
