Thank you for the 33 pounds of food items delivered to the pantry in March! Last month the pantry served 462 children, 793 adults, 364 seniors—a total of 1,619 people were served and seven new families were registered. The pantry is grateful for the 47 volunteers who contributed a combined 606 hours in March!

If you would like to donate food to the pantry, current items requested are: large and small jars of spaghetti sauce, 1- and 2-pound bags of rice, cereal, canned carrots, and canned mixed vegetables.


