The pantry is grateful for the 47 volunteers who contributed a combined 606 hours in March!

SHARING OUR TREASURES: April Update

It's hard to believe that we are already through the first quarter of 2024 and well into April! The condensed financial report below presents Zion's financial status at the end of March.

Our income exceeded our expenses for the month by \$7,604. This reduces our year-to-date shortfall to (\$6,384). This can be attributed in part to keeping actual expenses under budget by \$5,620, but also in part to increasing our giving by \$4,919 over the last month. *Thank you!* It is important to note that it was also a benefit that March had five Sundays compared to only four in February which means there was one extra week's worth of contributions. Expenses were maintained under budget, primarily under the property and administration categories. *Kudos!*

As always, we want to thank you for your financial support of Zion, its work, mission, and ministry in sharing God's love in our community and throughout the world. We are seeing a positive trend. As communicated earlier, our emphasis this year and going forward is <u>GENEROUS GIVING</u>. Stay tuned because Zion's stewardship ministry team will soon reveal additional and new ways to contribute that will hopefully make giving simpler!
