letter. I have resumed school again for my studies. All students put on masks while in class.


My Christmas and New Year celebration was very wonderful. We had Christmas with all family members and we had to pray at home since prayers were restricted for only a few people at a time.

May the blessings of God be upon you and the entire Zion Lutheran Church.






