The 3rd banner design is of an angel holding a heart above its head with swirls ascending, extending upward to God and the heavens. The 2nd banner has a candle with a heart in its flame and a swirl rising upward symbolizing prayer and commitment to God. This banner represents our turning to God. The 1st banner has a large, open hand of God with a heart in the middle of the hand and a swirl descending to us. INSTALLATION BREAKFAST FRENCH TOAST CASSEROLE

Many who were at the breakfast for Pastor Tim's installation have requested the recipe. You're in luck -- Amy Thompson has graciously agreed to share it! For those who did not get a chance to try it, here's your chance!

Ingredients:

½ loaf French bread, cubed (about 8 oz)
 ½ cup butter
 1 cup packed brown sugar
 2 cups milk
 2 tsp vanilla
 1 tsp cinnamon

6 eggs 1 Tsp brown sugar for topping

Powdered sugar (if desired)

Directions:

- 1. Preheat oven to 425 degrees.
- 2. Butter a 9x13 baking pan and set aside.
- 3. In a small saucepan, melt butter over medium heat. Once butter has melted, stir in brown sugar until dissolved and mixture is smooth. Pour mixture into the bottom of the 9x13 pan and spread evenly.
- 4. Add bread cubes to the pan spreading over the top of the butter/brown sugar mixture.
- 5. In a medium sized bowl whisk together the eggs, milk, vanilla, and cinnamon. Pour egg mixture over the pieces of bread.
- 6. Sprinkle with remaining tablespoon of brown sugar.
- 7. Bake in preheated oven for 25-30 minutes until top is golden brown.
- 8. Remove from oven and sprinkle with powdered sugar if desired.
