#### **ADVENT BANNERS**

As we prepare for the coming birth of Jesus, the anticipation builds as a banner in front of the Sanctuary is added each week. The  $3^{rd}$  banner design is of an angel holding a heart above its head with swirls ascending, extending upward to God and the heavens. The  $2^{nd}$  banner has a candle with a heart in its flame and a swirl rising upward symbolizing prayer and commitment to God. This banner represents our turning to God. The  $1^{st}$  banner has a large, open hand of God with a heart in the middle of the hand and a swirl descending to us. The idea is that God chooses us in grace and stirs our hearts in love and power.

*For those who asked for the French Toast Casserole recipe:* 1/2 loaf French bread cubed (about 8 oz)

 $\frac{1}{2}$  cup butter

- 1 cup packed brown sugar
- 6 eggs
- 2 cups milk
- 2 tsp vanilla
- 1 tsp cinnamon
- 1 Tsp brown sugar for topping

Powdered sugar (if desired)

#### **Directions:**

- 1. Preheat oven to 425 degrees.
- 2. Butter a 13x9 baking pan and set aside.
- In a small saucepan, melt butter over medium heat. Once butter has melted stir in brown sugar until

dissolved and mixture is smooth. Pour mixture into the bottom of the 9x13 pan and spread evenly.

- 4. Add bread cubes to the pan spreading over the top of the butter/brown sugar mixture.
- 5. In a medium sized bowl whisk together the eggs, milk, vanilla, and cinnamon. Pour egg mixture over the pieces of bread.
- 6. Sprinkle with remaining tablespoon of brown sugar.
- 7. Bake in preheated oven for 25-30 minutes until top is golden brown.
- 8. Remove from oven and sprinkle with powdered sugar if desired.



Zion will be serving a ham loaf dinner <u>this coming Thursday, December 15</u>. This will be the last meal for 2022. We hope you will be able to be a part of the preparation and serving of this meal as a Christmas gift to our community. After

taking a break over the holiday weeks, the meal will resume again on January 12, 2023.

Looking ahead, there are still many open dates for meal sponsors in 2023. *The critical dates are March 16 and March 30 when Mary will not be available to prepare a meal.* There are other open dates in February and then later in the spring. Please spread the word to your friends and neighbors in the community that help is needed!
