
Bible Study







To my fellow Zion members,

Upon meeting Joanne Grim when I joined Zion in 1984, I would smile when I'd see the little kids run to greet her on Sunday mornings. She would open her arms and they would enter into her loving embrace. She was their Zion Grandma. As the years passed, I realized she was a Grandma to all of us. She was usually a part of any event that required food preparation or distribution. She dispensed loving words when we shared our own trials with her. 
