




INTRODUCING JENNIFER EATON

Jennifer lives in Lancaster Pennsylvania with her 2-year-old Brittany Spaniel, River. River serves as her Service Dog, but when he is not working the two of them are out and about exploring and having fun. Their favorite place to go is Rader Park at Church of the Apostles. As an individual with low vision Jennifer has dedicated her life to providing the needed services, and resources to both children and adults who are also vision impaired or blind. Jennifer is employed by VisionCorps, where she is the Manager of Youth Services. As a Teacher of the Visually Impaired and Certified Orientation and Mobility Specialist Jennifer assists individuals of all ages reach their fullest potential in leading an independent life regardless of their vision loss.

When Jennifer is not out exploring with River or at work you will find her in her kayak. Jennifer is an OuttaSight paddler with natation organization; Team River Runner. TRR provides health and healing through water sports to members of the military, and members of the community with disabilities. Jennifer is the National Coordinator of the Kids Are OuttaSight Program. This program teaches children who are blind or vision impaired how



independently kayak. Jennifer is a white-water kayaker who loves the thrills of running a perfect line through a class 3 rapid on rivers like the Leigh or local creeks like Muddy Creek. Jennifer is also involved with the Mountville Lions Club and presents locally and regionally.
