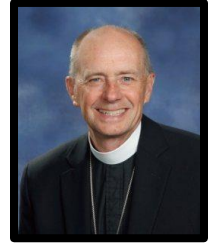

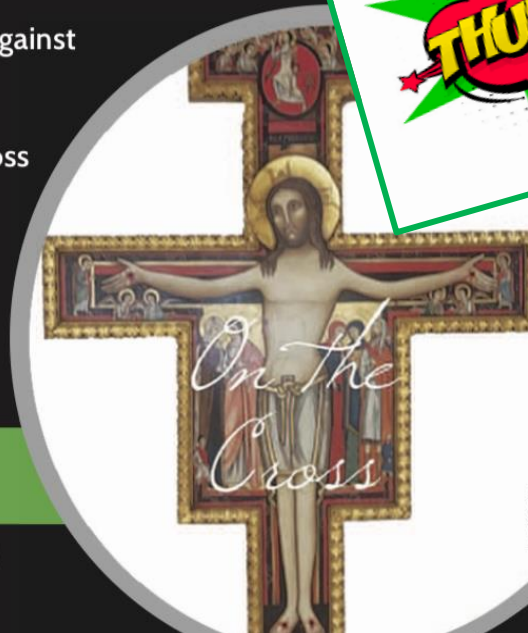

## SERMON ON THE MOUNT DEVOTIONALS

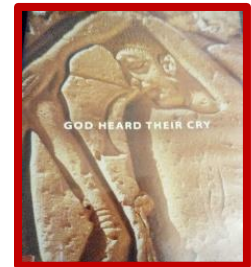

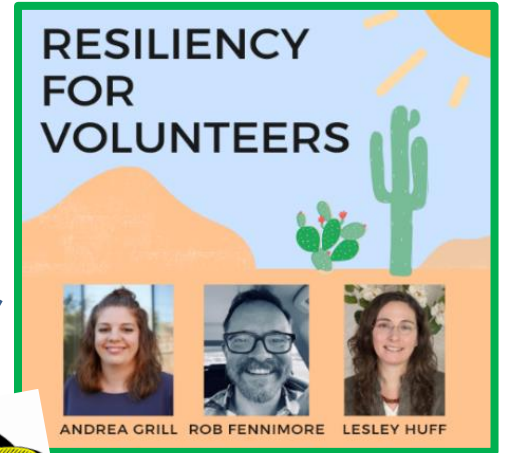
### THIS WEEK'S QUESTIONS

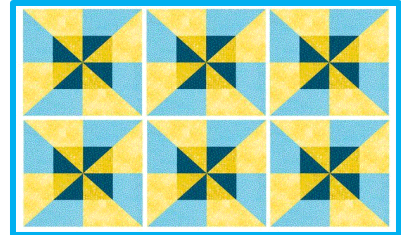

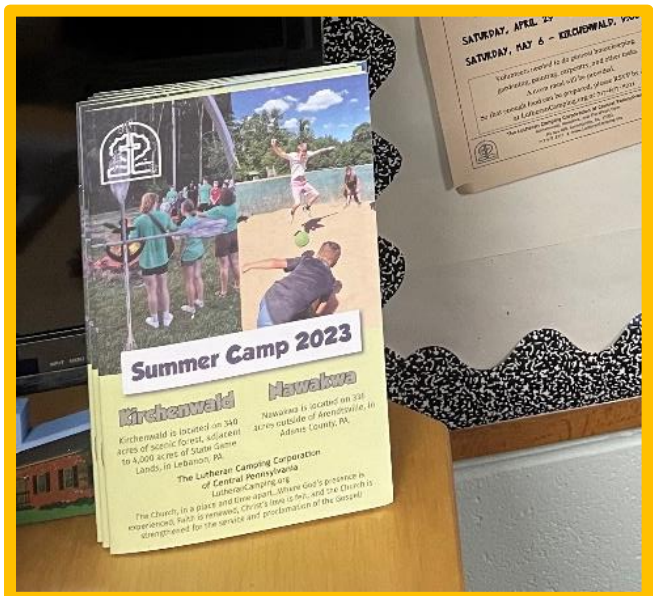
