LENTEN STUDY & FELLOWSHIP

During Lent (beginning on Thursday, February 23), Zion will be partnering with Holy Spirit and Redeemer Lutheran Churches for a six-week series focusing on "A Fresh Look at the Cross." The topics include: CSI:Jerusalem (medical aspects of the cross); Capital Punishment in the Roman Empire; the many ways the Church has understood how salvation works; the cross

for people whose "backs are against the wall"; interpreting the cross without dehumanizing Jewish people; and what the four Gospels teach us about Holy Week. Sessions will meet on Thursdays through Lent at 11 a.m. at Holy Spirit and will be recorded for anyone interested but unable to attend in person. After each session, you're invited to continue the fellowship with lunch at Centerville Diner!


TALENT/HOBBY SHOWCASE – Coming in March!



February 9 from 7-8:30 p.m. via Zoom; \$11






February 27 from 7–8:30 p.m. via Zoom; \$11
