JOYFUL NOISE COLLECTION



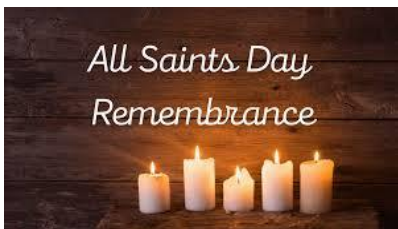
The Joyful Noise offering this month will go to Power Packs. This organization's mission is to empower families with education and ingredients to create nutritious weekend meals,

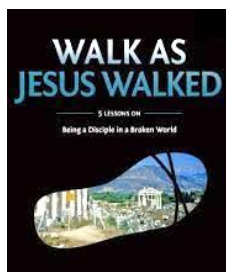
ADULT SUNDAY SCHOOL CLASSES

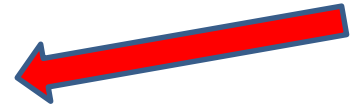

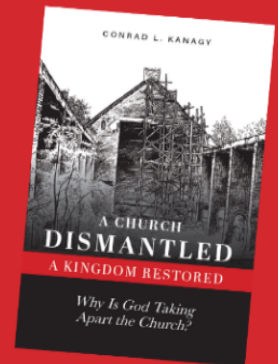
