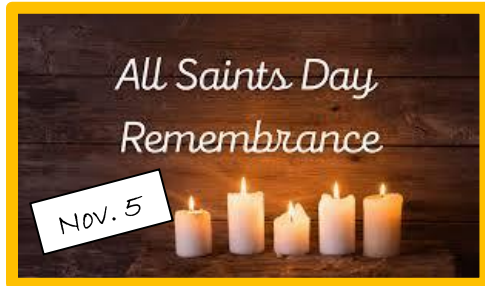

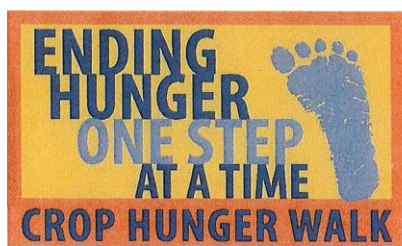
COMFORTER MINISTRY

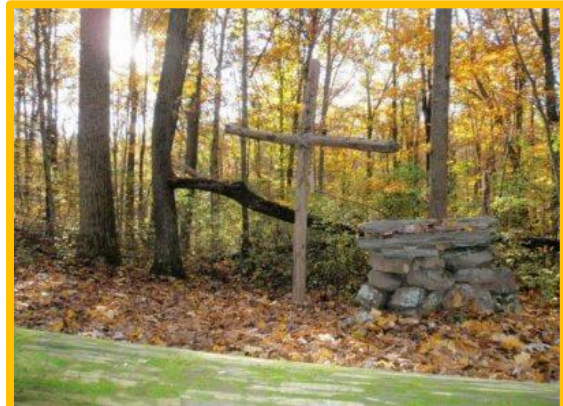
