SUNDAY SCHOOL CLASSES RESUME THIS SUNDAY

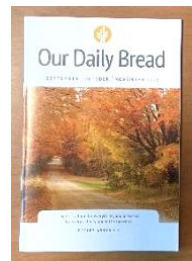

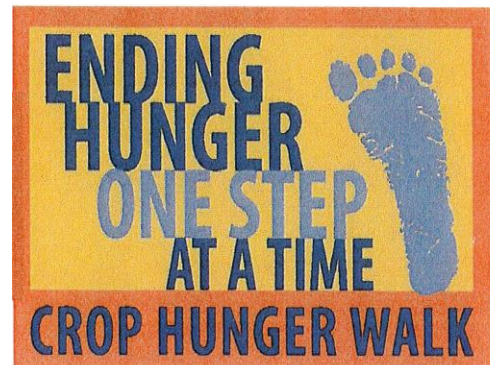
outside group is serving the meal, someone from the church needs to be there to answer any questions or to simply be a presence. Contact Mary with questions (717-333-6173)
