## PICNIC IN THE PARK

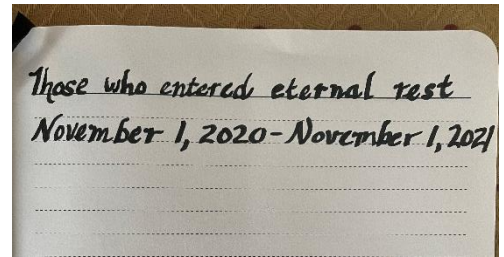
It has been a summer full of wonderful picnics at Rapho Twp. Community Park! The next picnic will be on September 30.

They will then be packed into boxes and delivered to the local drop-off area where they will then be taken to the LWR headquarters in Maryland. Upon their arrival at that warehouse, they will be shipped to all corners of the world, providing relief and comfort to refugees and those who have lost everything.

## FALL FOLIAGE DAYS

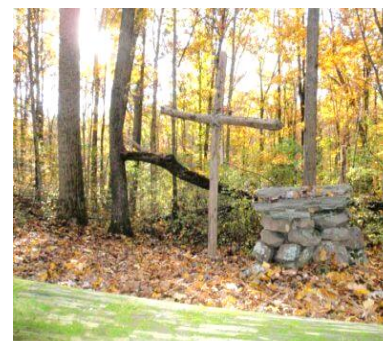
