PICNIC IN THE PARK


It has been a summer full of wonderful picnics at Rapho Twp. Community Park! The next picnic will be on September 30.

Upon their arrival at that warehouse, they will be shipped to all corners of the world, providing relief and comfort to refugees and those who have lost everything.

October 3; 3-5:30 p.m. @ Kirchenwald [Free]



October 24; 1-6 p.m. @ Kirchenwald and Nawakwa




