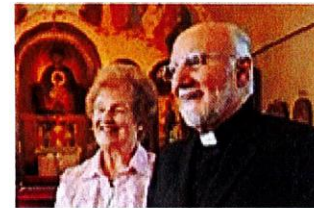

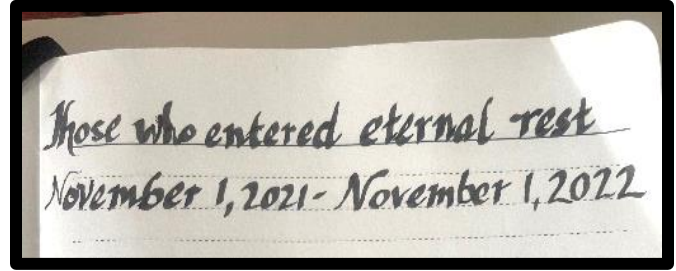


## ALL SAINTS REMEMBRANCE BOOK

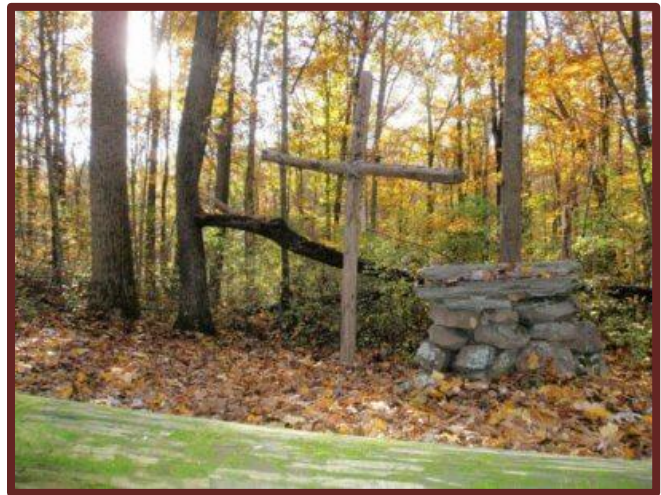
