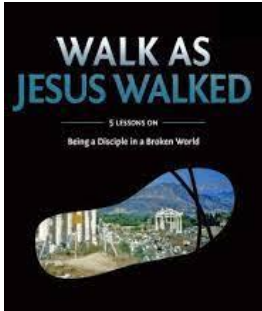

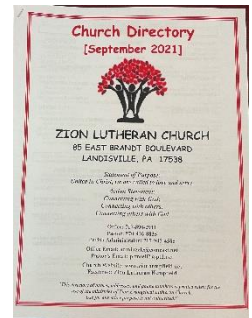
## ANNOUNCEMENTS, UPDATES, & EVENTS

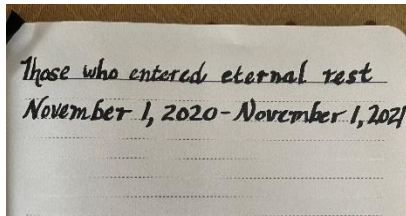


## WANT TO HELP WITH LWR SHIPPING COSTS?


