# **RMD DISTRIBUTION REQUIREMENT CHANGE**

We have been notified that the Retirement Enhancement Act was signed into law on December 20, 2019. *How might this affect you?* What has changed with this act is the age at which Required Minimum Distributions (RMDs) must begin has been raised from 70 1/2 to 72 for anyone who turns 70 1/2 after December 31, 2019. Anyone with questions on this change to their IRAs should contact their investment counselor.
