


Members Doris Hall-Gulati, clarinetist; Sara Male, cellist; and Maria Corley, pianist; are well known in the Lancaster area and beyond.

April 26: Pennsylvania Flute Choir


The Pennsylvania Flute Choir is an auditioned, community group formed in 2002 by flutist Georgia Dimaano. Heidi Bingham is the Music Director and Conductor for the Choir. Heidi joined us in 2015 and is excited to now be the conductor of the group. She began playing the flute at an early age, and has been part of ochestras, bands, and flute choirs in Oregon, Utah, Chicago, and Pennsylvania. In addition to her work with the Flute Choir, she does free-lance performance and teaches private lessons. 

Rizzetta's Tones is a Celtic and Folk band, comprised of 'fraternal twin' hammer dulcimers, silver flute, high and low whistles, and guitars. Their repertoire includes music from Ireland, Scotland, and the United States, drawing as well from the traditions of Finland, Brazil, France, Macedonia, and many other lands. Our name, honors Sam Rizzetta: engineer, scientist, pilot, dulcimer builder and player, innovator, composer, teacher, and friend. Sam has been notably instrumental in the resurrection and improvement of the hammer dulcimer from the 1960's to the present, and continues to work, teach, build, and play in West Virginia.

December 13: Hershey Handbell Ensemble Note: This concert will begin at 3:00pm

Formed in 2004, this auditioned community handbell ensemble is based in south-central Pennsylvania. They performed their inaugural concerts in Lebanon and Carlisle in Spring of 2004. The sixteen member group performs seasonally on seven octaves of Malmark Handbells, Handchimes, and assorted other instruments. The ensemble was formed to fulfill the need for an auditioned community ensemble comprised of persons able to play advanced literature, interested in advancing the art of handbell ringing through education and performance, and interested in uniting people through this musical art. The ensemble is under the direction of Artistic Director, Dr. Shawn Gingrich.
