That news clip scares me! Neither the Pastor nor I want to be the one to say we should go back to services immediately. I personally want to be cautious. I am, therefore, taking the stance that I will follow the recommendations of the Lower Susquehanna Synod Bishop and the CDC. Additionally, we are currently in the process of obtaining the proper disinfectant for use on the wooden pews in the Sanctuary as well as in other areas of the church building. Additionally, we are desperately trying to obtain hand sanitizer, backup masks, and gloves ... all items used for cleaning the church before and after each worship service to prohibit the spread of the virus.

Obviously, we need some prep time, and we need to see more positive declines in cases in our county. Once we are given the recommendations to go ahead by the Bishop and the CDC for safely re-opening the sanctuary and other areas of the building, we will, once again, consider having services.
