St. Nino (300s) was a slave-girl who was responsible for the evangelization of the kingdom of Georgia. She was most likely from Armenia and brought to Georgia. She told everyone she met about Jesus. The king and queen asked her to instruct them in the Christian faith. After his conversion, the king wrote to Emperor Constantine asking for clergy to be sent to instruct the people. Later she oversaw the construction of the first church in Georgia. She is credited with the conversion of the nation.
