### **JUST LIVING AND THINKING**

#### **Wednesday, March 24**

The other day as I was driving, I thought about all the different roles I have had in life: daughter, student, friend, Lutheran Deaconess, parish pastor, teacher, counselor, leader, musician, community member, historian, mother, mother-in-law, and on and on.
